Covid-19

Adults are encouraged to rapid Covid-19 test twice a week to help stay ahead of the virus. Test at home, report online each time, whether it is positive, negative or void.

The most important symptoms of COVID-19 are recent onset of any of the following: a new continuous cough; a high temperature or a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell. For most people, COVID-19 will be a mild illness. However, if you have any of the symptoms above, even if your symptoms are mild, stay at home and arrange to have a test.

In accordance with government guidance if your child has coronavirus symptoms please keep them at home and always seek a PCR test. Lateral Flow Device (LFD) tests should not be used on children under the age of 11 years old or on people with symptoms.
