## Gymnastics, Tennis and Trampolining

Classes One and Two will have weekly gymnastics sessions with Falcons Gymnastics for the first half of the term and weekly trampolining sessions with Air Extreme for the second half of the term. Gymnastics will take place on Wednesday afternoons starting on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> September. Trampolining will take place on Monday afternoons commencing on Monday 31<sup>st</sup> October.
