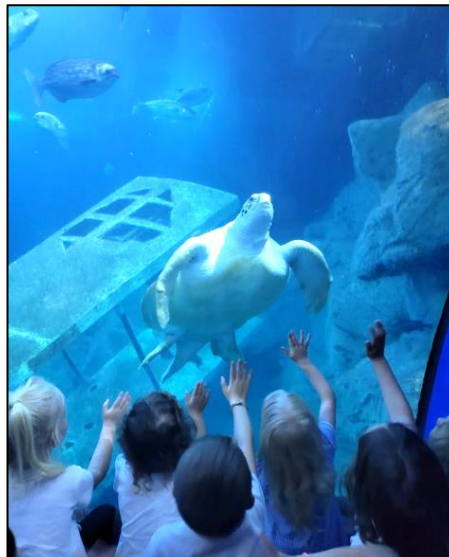
Years Four, Five and Six, Lively Action Workshops online with The Globe
