Year Six North Devon Wake Park

The children had a great time exploring a variety of water challenges. They all did so well and worked together as a team supporting and encouraging each other.



Year Six Science

Year 6 pupils had their first science lesson of the term. They took advantage of the lovely weather to explore the local environment. They collected leaves and used an app to help identify them. They also crushed some leaves with the help of a pestle and mortar and used a chemical to dissolve the green colour. In the next lesson they will use a special technique called chromatography to try to split the green colour up into different parts. The pupils learnt that the green colour is called "chlorophyll" and it is how the plants use the sun's energy to make food and oxygen.

Monday 11th September, Years Five and Six, "Sustainability Sussed" Workshop, Eden Project

This is a very exciting hands-on workshop which will support the topic of Sow, Grow and Farm. Pupil Absence - First Day Contact Procedures

- Telephone the Police on 101 if not at risk of immediate significant harm but where there are escalated welfare concerns
- Telephone the Police using 999 if the child is considered to be at risk of immediate and significant harm or danger
