Dear Parents and Carers,

Parking during drop offs and pick ups

Please make sure that you do not block the road when dropping off in the morning or picking up in the afternoon.

In the morning, a member of staff is at the blue gate for drop off and the expectation is that you stop briefly at the gate for your child to leave the vehicle and move on as soon as your child has entered the school premises safely, this should take a moment or two. If you need more time please park in a safe space at the side of the road, in the parking spaces outside the upper school or the Village Hall. Please do not leave your vehicle blocking the road.

In the afternoon, please do not abandon your vehicle in the middle of the road as this causes congestion down the hill and is a danger to children. If you intend to drive and pick up your child outside either gate and you arrive early please do not block the road. The pick up system works well when it flows but by leaving vehicles in the middle of the road is causing the potential for an accident. Many thanks in anticipation of your support.
