Year Six Science

In Science this week, Year Six were put into teams of two and given a mixture to separate. In the mixture was sand, iron filings, polystyrene beads, salt and some coins. We discussed how they were going to try to separate out the mixture. The tricky bit at the end, was to get the salt from the sand. They used hot water to dissolve the salt and then they used filter paper and a funnel to filter the mixture. The salty water went through the filter paper and they collected it in a pot. The salty water is currently sitting near the window of the classroom. Hopefully the water will start to evaporate and some salt crystals will grow in the pots!
