Year Six, National Gallery Online Workshop "Messengers"

The children were treated to a fascinating workshop led by Ed from the National Gallery. During the session, the children were encouraged to discuss shape, movement and their senses when exploring famous pieces by Van Gogh and Constable.



Years Three and Four, National Gallery Online Workshop "Colour and Light"

The children learnt about the artist Monet, what he was inspired by and the brush techniques he used. They explored colour mixing and creating texture through a variety of brush patterns and layering paint to create abstract master pieces.



Year Five, National Gallery Online Workshop "Van Gogh's Yellow House"

The children visually explored some of the works Van Gogh created and made observational sketches. They had fun experimenting with cutting and folding to construct their own artist's house.



Years One and Two, National Gallery Online Workshop "Colour and Light"

The children enjoyed looking at paintings in a new light by learning how artists make and use colour.

Free School Meals

All children in EYFS, Year One and Year Two are offered a free school meal as part of the Government's Universal Free School Meals for infants programme. If you receive a benefit that gives entitlement to free school meals, please apply for this by visiting Devon County Council's citizen portal (details enclosed) as the school can get additional funding to support your child.

You may be eligible for free school meals if as a parent or carer you are in receipt of one of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190 *)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400* a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
