Year Five, Lundy

The children had an amazing day visiting Lundy, exploring the lighthouse, the Marisco Castle and the caves that lie beneath the castle. They enjoyed observing the wildlife on and around the Island and were thrilled to see the coastguard conduct drills over the MS Oldenburg.



Key Stage Two, First Aid Training

The children thoroughly enjoyed learning invaluable information on the actions to take in an emergency situation. They were engaged in learning first aid techniques, working well together to put the patient into the recovery position and practised CPR on a manikin.


