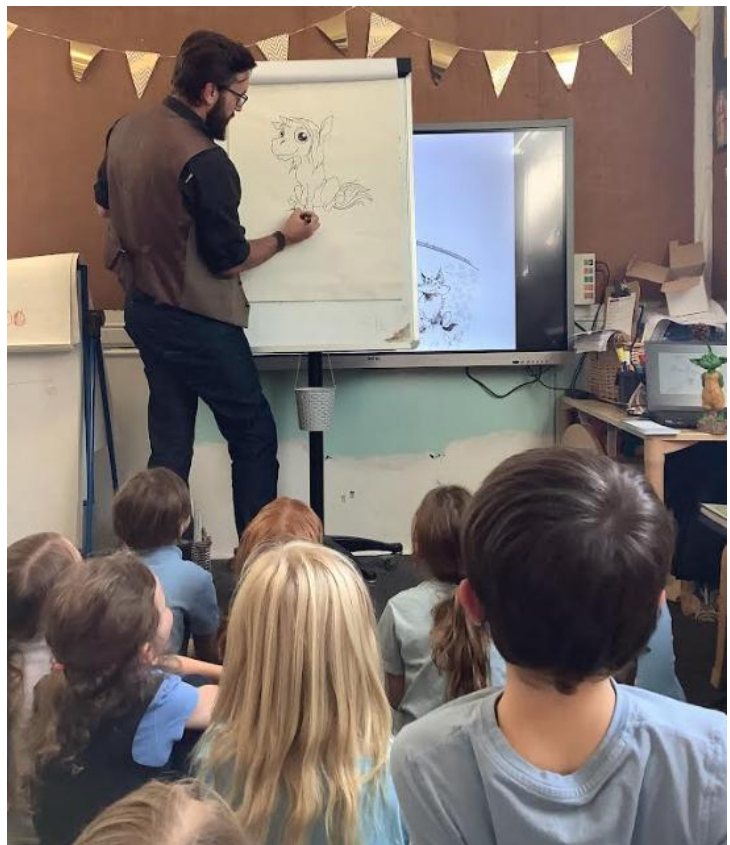
EYFS, Years One and Two, Futures Farm, Woolacombe
